You will be provided with slides but will need to bring the manual provided at the previous seminars with you, as you will need to refer to it at this event.

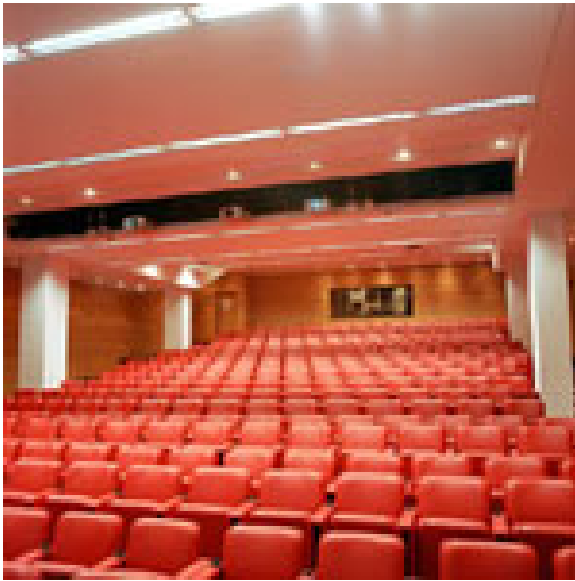
